About CoachLearn:

One of the key outcomes of the CoachLearn project CoachLearn aims to increase sport coaches' learning, mobility and employability by producing a European Sport Coaching Framework (ESCF) to act as a recognised reference point across the EU for the development of coach education programmes and coaching systems. The project is reaching an important milestone, as v1.1 of the ESCF is being produced, ready for a first consultation at the project's second multiplier event hosted by Trainerakademie. Coaching stakeholders from all over Europe will come together from 13th to 14th of October 2016 for updates, presentations and discussion. Consultation on the draft version of the ESCF will be the main focus of the event. The final version of the ESCF will be published in the summer of 2017. Furthermore, ten best practice examples are now available in topics such as coaching systems and frameworks and recognised prior learning and work-based experience to illustrate how different organisations are approaching these issues. About SCORE:

SCORE is a European project supported by the Erasmus+ Sport Programme, led by the European Non-Governmental Sports Organisation (ENGSO), which promotes gender equality in coaching, and focuses on increasing the number of employed and volunteer female coaches at all levels of sport as well as enhancing knowledge on gender equality in coach education. SCORE has developed a toolkit "awareness pack" with concrete tools to improve gender equality in coaching in sport organisations. Altogether 8 national training sessions have been organised around Europe to disseminate the toolkit and to educate participants from partner organisations and national sport federations to use it. Furthermore SCORE project has educated 22 mentors to support potential women to become a coach or to mentor female coaches to advance in their coaching career.
